

How to File and Serve Your Motion to Compel Discovery Unlawful Detainer



Make sure you have all your court forms.

- It is very important that you read the instructions on this sheet.
- Take all your court forms with you to court.

Follow these steps.

- 1. Read and review for correctness, then sign the forms.** Sign your full name, and print your address, telephone number and date on the ORIGINAL court form and all COPIES in the space provided. The ORIGINAL does not have the word COPY printed in the top right corner. You should have an Original and 2 COPIES.
 - 2. DELIVER** a COPY of your motion to your landlord or his lawyer (if there is one). You can do this by either hand-delivery or through the mail.
 - 3.** On your ORIGINAL, **circle whether you hand-delivered or mailed** this motion to your landlord and the date you did this.
 - 4. DELIVER** the ORIGINAL to the court after you have delivered a copy to your landlord.
- IMPORTANT: You must file your motion to compel with the landlord and the court within five (5) business days of the date the responses to your discovery were due.**
- 5.** The other COPY is for you to keep.
 - 6.** The hearing on your Motion To Compel Discovery will be held on the rescheduled trial date. Be prepared to go ahead with your eviction trial on that date since there is always a chance that the judge will not order your landlord to answer discovery or postpone the trial date.
