

- **Answer to Complaint Re: Parental Obligation**

Respond to a governmental request for child support.

- **Eviction**

Evict a tenant or defend yourself from an eviction.

- **Guardianship**

Ask the court to appoint you or another person as the guardian of a child

- **Income and Expense Declaration**

Fill out financial paperwork

- **License Denial Review**

Ask the court to restore a license revoked by the Department of Child Support Services

- **Name Change**

Change your name and/or the names of family members.

- **Notice of Motion**

Respond to a request for child support payments by the Department of Child Support Services

- **Domestic Violence Restraining Order**

Request or respond to a restraining order because of domestic violence .

- **Summary Dissolution**

Divorce through a simple process

- **Wage and Earnings Assignment Hearing Request**

Dispute child support

- **Civil Harrasment**

Request or respond to a restraining order to stop harassment.

- **Advance Health Care Directive**

Give power of attorney to someone else to make medical decisions.



Quick Reference

Order to Show Cause

Request or respond to spousal support, property orders, child support, custody, visitation and/or attorney fees. You can request your first orders, make changes to existing orders, request ex-parte emergency orders, or respond to an OSC.

Divorce

Divorce your spouse or respond to a divorce. Prepare initial and final financial paperwork. After six months, prepare a proposed judgment to finalize your divorce.

Paternity Petition

Claim or respond to a claim that you or someone else is the parent of a child. Also prepare your Judgment.

Fee Waiver

Ask the court to reduce your fees because you cannot afford to pay

Small Claims

Sue or counter-sue in Small Claims Court. Ask for a later hearing date. After your hearing collect your money or correct, cancel or appeal your judgment.
