

How to use I-CAN! to Create Small Claims After Hearing Forms



Follow these steps

- Be sure to print or save the PDF file with your password so you can re-enter if there are any disruptions
1. Select your language preference, video preference and then select the Module you want to complete.
 2. The next screen will give you a description of the module. Click "Next" and then choose "Create a username and password".
 3. At the end of the tutorial and disclaimer, enter your first and last name and click "Next". I-CAN! will create a unique password for you. Be sure to print or save the PDF file with your password so you can re-enter if there are any disruptions.
 4. If you want to re-enter a module using a user you have created, select "Log in with my password" and then enter in your password. You will be taken back to the module with your responses already filled in.

What does I-CAN! do?

I-CAN! will fill out the forms for you by asking you simple questions and putting your answers on the court forms in the correct place. I-CAN! will print all of the forms that are necessary for your individual situation. I-CAN! will also print instructions to tell you what to do with your forms, and how the court process works.

Who can use the Small Claims After Hearing module?

CA Small Claims After Hearing

Users

- A user who wants to collect their money after they have a judgment
- A user who wants to cancel or correct their judgment
- A user who wants to appeal their judgment

After you have had a Small Claims hearing, I-CAN! will help you to file after-hearings forms. You can request to be allowed to collect your money if you won your case. You can also ask the judge to correct your judgment if there was a clerical error, cancel your judgment if the court applied the wrong law to your case, or appeal your judgment if you want to have your case heard again as if it was a new case.

How to go through the Small Claims After Hearing Module

Enter the following information

Scenario 1: You are a Plaintiff wanting to collect your small claim after the hearing.

1. Your name is John Smith. Your phone number is 222-444-8888. You are the plaintiff and you are suing a person.
2. Your current address is 5555 Wee St., Weeville, CA, 33333. This is the same address that you used in your small claims form.
3. There are no more Plaintiffs in your case.
4. The defendant's name is William Brown. The defendant's phone number is 333-666-9999. The defendant is a person. The defendant's current address is 888 WeeWee St., Weeville, CA, 77777.
5. There are no more defendants in your case.
6. You would like to get a writ of execution so you can collect on your judgment. Your judgment was entered on 06/20/2008. The total amount of your judgment was \$700. Your judgment was not renewed and you have filed a *Memorandum of Costs* before.
7. The debtor has paid you some amount of your judgment. He paid you \$10. The debtor owes you \$100 in interest.
8. You do not want to subpoena a witness or documents
9. There are no other orders you would like to request.
10. You do not want to ask for a Wage Garnishment to collect your judgment.
11. Your case name that is listed on the forms is Smith v. Brown. Your case number is 123456789. You filed your hearing forms in Los Angeles County. You will file your after hearing forms in Long Beach Courthouse.

Variations: Try adding more plaintiffs or defendants. Try collecting your small claim from a business. Try asking to subpoena a witness or document. Try asking for more orders from the court of asking for a Wage Garnishment. Try requesting to correct or cancel your judgment.

Scenario 2: You are a defendant appealing a small claims judgment.

1. Your name is John Smith. Your phone number is 222-444-8888. You are the defendant in your case and you are a person.
2. Your current address is 7777 Wee St., Weeville, California, 88888. This is not the same address used on your small claims forms. You moved on 06/01/2008.
3. There are no more defendants in your case.
4. The plaintiff's name is William Brown. His phone number is 333-666-9999. The plaintiff is a person. The plaintiff's current address is 8699 Trams St., Weeville, CA, 13131.
5. There are no more plaintiffs in this case.
6. You would like to appeal your judgment. You would like to appeal your small claims judgment.
7. The case name on your form is Smith v Brown. Your case number is 123456789.
8. The county where you will file your after hearing forms is Nevada County.
9. The court where you will file you after hearing forms is Court County of Nevada.
